MUHAMMAD ALI FACTS

1. **Born Cassius Clay:** Muhammad Ali was born Cassius Marcellus Clay Jr. on January 17, 1942, in Louisville, Kentucky. He later changed his name after converting to Islam in 1964, when he was influenced by the Nation of Islam.
